



It's been another fantastic year at Lighthouse! We enlarged our full-service optical and pharmacy, with plans for Kenya's first Eye Bank, all found within our new annex building across from the eye center!! LFC Fellowship of Churches now have 100 churches that continue to grow with plans to plant another 2 by year's end!

Lighthouse's 3 national ophthalmologists and many volunteer U.S. eye specialists brought sight to nearly 2,000 poor and blind children and adults! Volunteer church teams from the States built several new churches, held pastors and wives' conferences, bringing great encouragement!! The Jesus Film was taken to remote bush villages that continue to yield a great harvest of souls and build our local churches throughout the East Coast and all the way to Nairobi!

Here are two wonderful stories about how you helped us continue serving the physically and spiritually blind!



Nassir Kyalo was born and raised as a devout Muslim. As a teen, he began to question his faith. By reading a Bible and attending church, he gave his life to Jesus Christ. He was under great persecution from his family and friends. It became so intense that they had to flee their home. He enrolled and graduated from LFCM Bible School, taught Sunday School and became a deacon at his church, and then was ordained as a pastor. He planted a LFCM church by first meeting with a small group of believers under a tree and then built a mud hut to meet in. The tiny church grew!

A few weeks ago, they received a wood and tin church structure built by a volunteer team from Kentucky! They have seen the community around the church come to know Jesus Christ. **Nassir's story is a reminder that God can use anyone to accomplish His purposes!**

Mwanbaji had been struggling with very poor vision, which had led to not being able to work, to get around independently, or even spend time with his grandchildren. When a local Lighthouse pastor recommended he visit the Lighthouse eye clinic for help, he had such hope and joy for his future. He even had friends who also needed help with their vision, and they went together! He was diagnosed by our doctor with cataracts and had a successful surgery. He says "We did not leave the way we came. We can see! I can safely go home to my family and am thankful for this team of doctors! Thank you, thank you, thank you!"
